

CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)

Supplement to Standard Training Module

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW

This standard Vivid training module provides overview Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). Although there is currently not an OSHA standard for CPR, it is important to note that hands-on training is recommended with this module to complete the CPR re-certification process.

In addition to the general overview, employees *should* receive facility and work-specific training. This additional training *should* cover:

- Company policies regarding administering first aid and CPR during a medical emergency
- Situations at the facility that may require CPR intervention

This training is not intended as initial CPR certification for an employee.

Frequency: This training *should* be provided at the time of employment and when employee responsibilities change. CPR certification training is typically required at least once every three years.
